



Academic Support Program

The Academic Support Team provides services to students who currently have an individualized education plan (IEP). These students are fully included in the regular classroom setting. Small group tutoring periods are provided within the students' academic schedules. The Academic Support Team consistently monitors the progress of its students and communicates regularly with the teachers and staff at Badin High School to assure that each students' needs are met. We strive to develop a student's advocacy skills such that he/she can continue to be successful with his/her post-secondary goals.

Targeted Areas:

- Providing practice with the goals listed in the individual education plans or individual service plans (Reading, Math, Written Expression, Organization, Study Skills)
- Assisting with homework completion/test preparation
- Developing organizational skills
- Providing testing accommodations as noted in the IEPs and ISPs
- Reviewing transition goals
- Preparation for the ACT, PSAT, ASVAB and our State Tests (IOWAs) through various resources/programs.
