



HIGH SCHOOL CREDIT ALGEBRA I ACTION PLAN

1. Student will take an Algebra I class in their current 8th grade setting. The class will follow the approved Archdiocese course of study for Algebra I.
2. Student will take two assessments, one in February and one in May at Badin High School. These assessments are created and scored by the Badin High School Math Department.
3. Earning early high school credit will provide the student with more flexibility in their high school schedule. Students will still be required to take four years of math at Badin High School.
4. Badin High School will grant high school credit to all students who meet the required criteria. The two Badin assessments and their grade school Algebra I final percentage will be combined using the following weights:
 - Unit 1 Test: 35%
 - Unit 2 Test: 35%
 - Final Algebra 1 Grade: 30%

The resulting score must be 80% or higher in order to earn high school credit.

Unit Test 1: Tuesday, February 8th 3:00-4:30 OR Wednesday, February 9th 8:00-9:30

Unit Test 2: Tuesday, May 10th 3:00-4:30 OR Wednesday, May 11th 8:00-9:30

- Please note, this test is separate from the High School Placement test, which determines math level.
