Frequently Asked Questions	
What materials should I bring home?	Take all materials home with you that will be needed to work from home: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Textbooks• Notebooks and binders• Novels/books• General school supplies
What kind of course work should I expect?	Each of your classes will be posting two assignments per week. They have staggered these assignments to be due at different times to not overload you. Teachers have been instructed to create assignments/post material that should take you 30 minutes. This amounts to roughly 8 hours of work per week.
How often should I check Google Classroom?	All work will be posted to Google Classroom. Please be sure to check Google Classroom every day for information concerning each course. Your teachers will be posting assignments and due dates. It is expected that you turn in your work on time.
What happens if I miss a deadline?	Please communicate directly with your teachers. Even though school is cancelled for three weeks, you are still expected to get your work in on time. If an issue emerges and you are unable to meet a deadline, please let that teacher know.
How can I communicate with my teachers during our time away from school?	The best way to contact your teacher is through email. If you are unsure of your teacher's email address, please look here: Contact Information
What if I cannot access work at home?	Have a classmate or parent send an email to your teachers describing the issue that you are having. Teachers will be checking their email daily.
What will happen with AP testing? ACTs? Other standardized tests?	At this time, we do not have guidance concerning these tests. As soon as we have information, Mr. Keating will share that information with students and parents.
